After the 2002 Bali bombing which took 202 lives, Marilyn Murray began her ongoing project of generosity and practical compassion for the local Balinese. What she has begun is clearly illustrated in a brief inventory of her work to date:

- * Over A\$60,000 has been raised in 3 big fundraisers
- * 7 schools have received stationery packs
- * 1 school has been rebuilt by Rotary Caringbah
- * 1 school has had a new toilet block rebuilt
- * 4 schools currently have over 50 disadvantaged children sponsored
- * 7 disabled children/adults have 28 sponsors

March 2007 will be her 8th trip to Bali since the bombing. Marilyn visits 2 schools and takes for each sponsored child, a bag with stationery, toys and collectable items. From 380kg of stationery on the first trip, Marilyn is now taking around 500kg per trip.

Over the past 4 years, Marilyn has watched many sponsored children grow, among them the top student at Mas 6 school who is now being sponsored through high school. She acknowledges the generosity of sponsors through whom children can attain an education, and have hope for employment in the future.

Marilyn speaks with passion about the practical needs of disabled Balinese: "Most sleep on a mat on concrete. We aim to provide a bed and bedding for all the disabled people being sponsored."
